This position provides full time Environmental Health & Safety leadership to site operations and will ensure that all practices are in compliance with Federal, State, and Local laws. This position is responsible for coordinating regulatory programs and permit applications.

- Manage the facility contractor safety program with facility contractor coordinators.

- Establish strategies, create awareness, and implement safety programs regarding forklifts, personal protective equipment, fire protection, SDS, hearing conservation, hazardous materials, material handling and storage, electrical safety-related work practices, blood borne pathogens, confined space, lock out tag out, and emergency action planning.
- Workers' compensation claim management.
- Environmental monitoring, reporting, and permitting.
- Champion the facility Process Safety Management Program.
