



## ENGINE ROOM SUPERVISOR

This position is responsible for oversight of day to day operations of all engine room equipment including steam boilers, ammonia refrigeration system, compressed air system, plant water system, and CO<sub>2</sub> system, as well as maintenance responsibilities for said equipment. This position is responsible for developing the P&ID's and detailed process flows for growth and continuous improvement projects.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include, but are not limited, to:

- Design and support procedures for the efficient maintenance of the Engine Room.
- Effectively implement and monitor programs for the operation of Utilities, Water Treatment, Ammonia Systems and Engine Room.
- Maintain and improve a preventive maintenance system using CMMS.
- Development of mechanical specifications for the preparation of P&ID's, and P&ID database.
- Definition of mechanical design conditions for equipment and piping components, including the design and sizing of safety relief valves, and Cv calculations of control valves.
- Effectively troubleshoot causes for deviations from specifications from regulatory agenda and communicate with the appropriate agencies.
- Ensure compliance with Process Safety Management program. Maintain related policies.
- Effectively manage and motivate a work force of hourly employees.
- Project Management:
  - Develop, implement and provide oversight of projects to ensure compliance with local, state, and federal regulatory requirements.
  - Submit complete financial justifications for proposed equipment and Engine Room related capital.
  - Ensure project requirements are within established budget and timeframes.
  - Interface with, and manage, project specific contractors when required.

### ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure department compliance with applicable safety policies and regulations.
- Interface with vendors and bring knowledge and experience.
- Perform other duties as necessary in support of business objectives.

### QUALIFICATIONS

This position requires a high level of technical competence regarding engine room, utilities, and ammonia refrigeration systems.

- College graduate with four-year engineering, or relevant, degree.
- Three to five years of supervisory experience, with engine room oversight, experience in food or beverage manufacturing preferred.
