### POSITION SUMMARY

Within a team environment, the Engineering Manager is responsible for process development and improvement initiatives within the Company. The Engineering Manager will interface directly with City Brewing departments to design, maintain and improve organizational practices and manufacturing processes.

This position requires a high level of technical competence and ability to grow the competitive capabilities of the Company. It also requires that this individual understands company philosophy and helps achieve customer service and other company goals. Finally, this position requires an individual who is planful, articulate and above all else, resourceful to accomplish required objectives.

The ideal candidate will have experience with Process Safety Management, Ammonia refrigeration, Project Management, and Process optimization.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Actively participate in Site's PSM program, as well as being primary element owner for some of the required elements (MOC, PSSR, PSI, etc.)
- Write SOPs and train production personnel to process improvement specifications
- Work with Quality Department to identify areas of improvement.
- Design, communicate, implement, manage and evaluate capital projects
- Assist all department Heads/Managers/Supervisors in trouble-shooting process/production problems.
- Must be able to work alone and be able to provide a hands-on approach to problem solving.
- Support site maintenance teams in leveraging existing CMMS system to drive world class preventative and predictive maintenance programs
- Review and evaluate existing and new processes.
- Provide strategic input regarding capital planning and associated project benefits.
- Submit complete financial justifications for proposed equipment or other process-related capital.
