ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides on the floor manufacturing support to operations and quality team with 24 hour coverage to facilitate continuous improvement.
- Audit, evaluate, monitor, track, and report supplier non-conformances.
- Monitors, improve, and validates quality processes in packaging.
- Determination of investigation strategies as needed with internal and external resources.
- Analyzes data to identify any trends and provides information to department personnel.
- Performs accurate and timely data entry.
- Initiates, manages, and investigates deviations with supporting data and root cause analysis.
- Support disposition activities of finished goods.
- Serves as a QA subject matter expert for established quality standards and procedures, sanitation, and technical support to optimize existing equipment/processes.
- Collaborates to qualify new vendors and trials.
- Quality management in packaging material – investigation, reclamation, continuous improvement
- Audit processes in packaging.
- Performs other duties assigned as needed.
